MINORS AND CONCENTRATIONS

Legal Studies Concentration

Provides students with an in-depth understanding of the American legal system. While this program is especially appropriate for students who are considering law-related careers, it is open to all political science majors who wish to learn more about the U.S. Constitution, the legal process, the courts, and the fundamental rights of citizens in a democratic society. In addition, the department offers an advisory service to students interested in law school.

Political Communications Concentration

Provides students with an in-depth understanding of both political institutions and processes and communication theory and techniques. This program prepares undergraduates to become policy advocates, campaign executives, public relations officers, political consultants and other political professionals whose work is to create, shape, and distribute messages that influence the political process.

Geography Minor

Promotes geographic literacy by building student knowledge and appreciation of diverse populations and environments. It develops student critical thinking and spatial reasoning skills and fosters respect and understanding of cultures around the world. Foundational study of geography is good preparation for a multitude of careers as well as graduate study, especially for those with interests in international affairs, world regions, culture and history, and human-land relationships.

CAREERS

 Our graduates pursue careers in public service including CIA, FBI, AmeriCorp, or Peace Corps, and local and national politics.

- Program graduates further their education by attending prestigious graduate schools such as New York University, American University, Ohio State University, University of Maryland, George Mason University, University of Bremen (Germany), and West Virginia University.
- Those interested in legal careers have gone on to law schools such as the University of Pennsylvania, American University, Penn State University, West Virginia University, Liberty University, and Michigan State University.
