SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION

If you desire, you can have a forensic exam for up to 96 hours following a sexual assault to collect evidence.

Confidential Support Advisors

The Title IX or Student Conduct Office can connect you with confidential support advisors on-campus or advocates off campus to assist and support you during this time.

Eastern Panhandle Empowerment Center

A confidential domestic violence and sexual assault crisis center serving both men and women.

Services include emotional support, counseling, emergency shelter and a 24 hour hot line.

Health Center Shepherd University 304-876-5161

Provides emergency contraception, testing and treatment for STIs, and sexual assault counseling and referrals.

Provides treatment for STIs, and rape testing with a sexual assault nurse examiner. Advocates are available on call.
