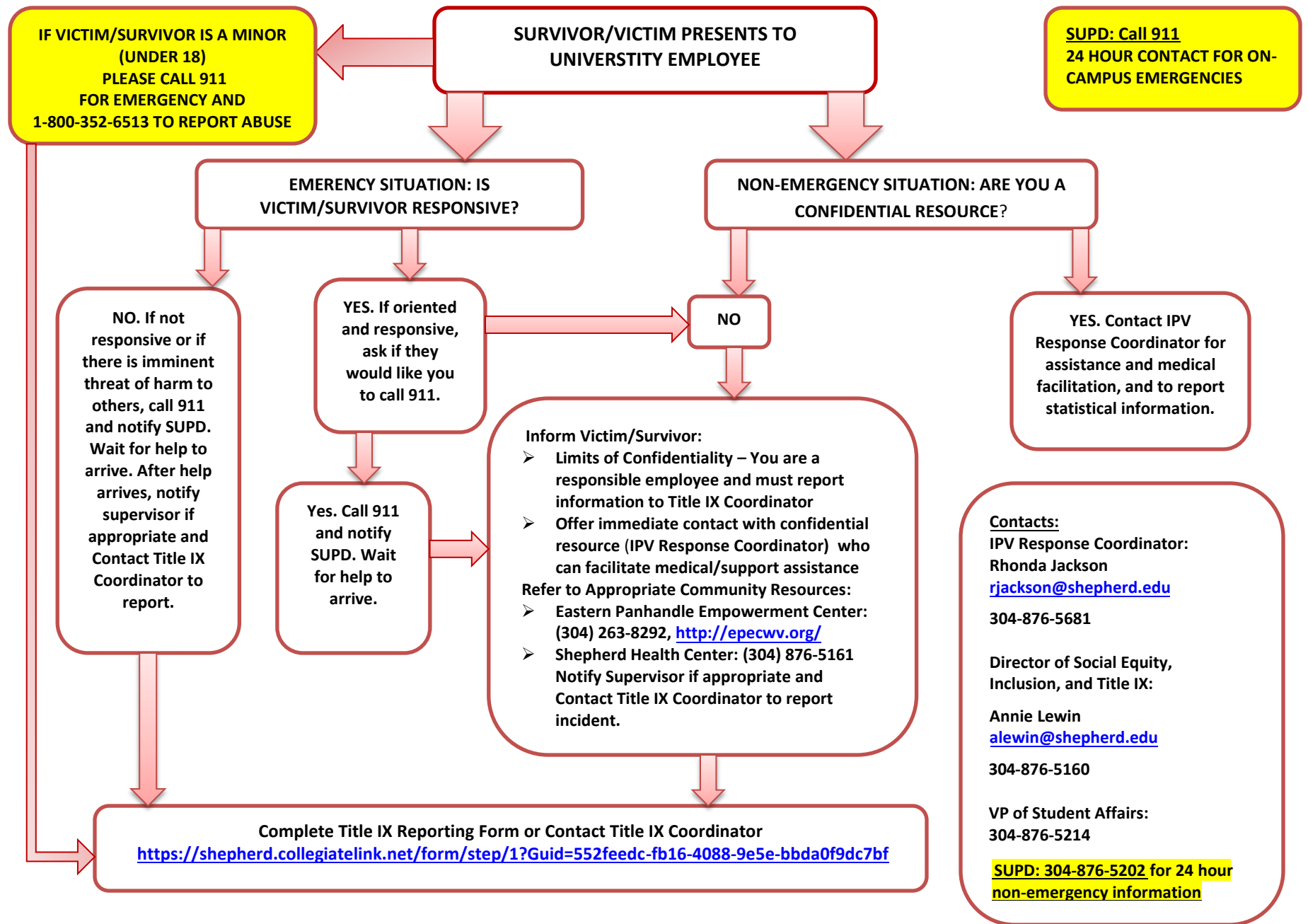


**Title IX and Interpersonal Violence Response Protocol**



**IF VICTIM/SURVIVOR IS A MINOR (UNDER 18) PLEASE CALL 911 FOR EMERGENCY AND 1-800-352-6513 TO REPORT ABUSE**

**SUPD: Call 911 24 HOUR CONTACT FOR ON-CAMPUS EMERGENCIES**

**EMERGENCY SITUATION: IS VICTIM/SURVIVOR RESPONSIVE?**

**NON-EMERGENCY SITUATION: ARE YOU A CONFIDENTIAL RESOURCE?**

**NO. If not responsive or if there is imminent threat of harm to others, call 911 and notify SUPD. Wait for help to arrive. After help arrives, notify supervisor if appropriate and Contact Title IX Coordinator to report.**

**YES. If oriented and responsive, ask if they would like you to call 911.**

**Yes. Call 911 and notify SUPD. Wait for help to arrive.**

**NO**

**YES. Contact IPV Response Coordinator for assistance and medical facilitation, and to report statistical information.**

**Inform Victim/Survivor:**

- Limits of Confidentiality – You are a responsible employee and must report information to Title IX Coordinator
- Offer immediate contact with confidential resource (IPV Response Coordinator) who can facilitate medical/support assistance
