

Tutoring Options at Shepherd

Shepherd University offers several methods of tutoring available to all students with no additional charge.

Peer tutoring: Housed in the Academic Support Center (ASC), peer tutoring offers students one-on-one help with specific assignments, subjects, and topics. For Fall 2020, appointments are offered in-person and online.

How to sign up:

- Visit <https://www.shepherd.edu/academic-support/>
- Click "Schedule a Tutor"
- Register for an account using your SU email
- Select the week you need tutoring
- Select the course you need help with
- Review the available tutors and select a time slot that works for you

➤ Note: if you cannot attend your appointment, contact the ASC at least 24 hours in advanced

ShepOWL: Hosted by the ASC, ShepOWL allows students to submit written assignments and essays via Sakai for review.

How to add ShepOWL to you Sakai sites:

- Log onto Sakai and click on "Home" (top left hand side)
- On the Tool Navigation Menu (left-hand side), click on "Membership"
- Click on the tab "Joinable Sites" on the top
- Select "201630-ENGL-999:01"
- Click on "Sites" on the top right hand corner
- Find and click on "201630-ENGL-999:01" under PROJECTS to enter ShepOWL
