**Earn High School and
College Credit

Students attending a high school in Jefferson County may be enrolled in both high school and college at the same time, while **receiving college and high school credit simultaneously**.

Students who wish to enroll in the program must:

- complete their sophomore year or equivalent of total credits.
- have an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- meet the specific ACT, SAT, or Accuplacer score requirements if they wish to enroll in an English, math, or ECON 205 course.

- Meet with your school counselor to determine whether courses will count as required or elective credits. Failure of college courses can affect graduation requirements.

- Obtain a letter of recommendation from principal, school counselor, or homeschool evaluator.
- Submit a signed approval form from your parent(s) or legal guardian(s). Request the form from your school counselor.
- Obtain an official copy of high school transcript.
- Submit all of the above by deadline to **Shepherd University Office of Admissions**.
- Have your official ACT or SAT scores sent to Shepherd University (if needed) from CollegeBoard. ACT code 4532 and SAT code 5615.
