GUIDELINES FOR THE ADMISSIONS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

1. This form is for new students. Applicants must be admitted to Shepherd University.
2. A FAFSA must be filed to be considered for financial need scholarships.
3. Two letters of recommendation must accompany the scholarship application.
4. A personal statement must accompany the application. Possible writing prompts include:
 - a. Have you faced a challenge or failure? How has that affected you? How did you learn and grow from the experience?
 - b. We are looking for students who will become positive additions to our student body. If this describes you, please share how you'll become involved at Shepherd and what your background, identity, interests or talents will add to our student community.
 - c. Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.
 - d. Choose an essay topic of your choice.
5. For priority consideration, applications should be submitted by March 1st for fall admission and November 1st for spring admission.
