Students who wish to enroll in the program must:

- complete their sophomore year or equivalent of total credits.
- have an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- meet the specific ACT, SAT, or Accuplacer score requirements if they wish to enroll in an English, math, or ECON 205 course.

- Obtain a letter of recommendation from the principal or director of guidance.
- Submit a signed approval form from your parent(s) or legal guardian(s). Request the form from the Goretti Guidance Office.
- Obtain an official copy of high school transcript.
- Submit all of the above by deadline to **Shepherd University Office of Admissions**.
- Have your official ACT or SAT scores sent to Shepherd University (if needed) from CollegeBoard. ACT code 4532 and SAT code 5615.

PLEASE NOTE: Collegiate coursework and schedule must be approved in advance by the principal for student to receive Goretti credit.
