FALL EVENT VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

1. Family Day – Saturday, September 25 @ 10am, Midway
 - a. Assisting Katie and Hannah with games and giveaway table for students and their family members

2. Freedom's Run – Friday, October 15 and Saturday, October 16
 - a. Jobs for Friday include:
 - i. Three packet pick-up shifts
 - ii. Hospitality race liaison
 - iii. Race course/finish line set up
 - b. Jobs for Saturday include:
 - i. Race day registration
 - ii. Two food tent shifts
 - iii. Course clean up
