**\*\*\*Variable credit for HNRS 489:** Most Honors students take HNRS 489 for 1 credit. HNRS 489 should only be taken for 2-3 credits by prior approval of the Honors Director if there is substantial additional research undertaken outside major capstone courses after the student completes HNRS 488 or the equivalent contracted course.
