

WISH PRESENTS FIRST COURAGE TO INSPIRE, STRENGTH TO EMPOWER AWARD

Women Investing in Shepherd University (WISH) presented its first Courage to Inspire, Strength to Empower Award to Shepherd alumna Danielle Stephenson '20 of Charles Town, West Virginia. Created to recognize and cultivate the next generation of women philanthropists, the award is presented to outstanding female student leaders whose service and commitment to excellence benefit and inspire members of the Shepherd community. Winners are announced during the annual WISH Membership Program and are invited to vote as an honorary member for that year's grant awards.

Since joining the Ram family in 2016, Danielle has raised over \$2,000 for Children's Miracle Network Hospitals. She has also traveled over 1,000 miles throughout the state to educate West Virginia youth on the drug epidemic as part of a program she created called Too Smart to Start. As an undergraduate, Danielle

served as both president and vice president of the Student Government Association and sat on the Shepherd University Board of Governors. She also served the Delta Zeta sorority as vice president of philanthropy and has planned events for local and national agencies, including the Eastern Panhandle Empowerment Center and Starkey Hearing Foundation.

In her current role as the graduate assistant for Shepherd's student community service, Danielle is involved with stocking the Ram Pantry, created to help food-insecure students, faculty, and staff. She is also busy promoting her newest initiative, G.I.V.E Through Volunteerism, which aims to bring volunteer activities directly to West Virginia residents. Danielle's meaningful philanthropic work both on and off campus truly embodies the commitment of WISH to impact and enhance the Shepherd community.

MAJOR GIFT BENEFITS SEEDING YOUR FUTURE INITIATIVE

A major gift made through the Shepherd University Foundation in 2020 was designated in support of Shepherd University's Seeding Your Future Initiative. The gift was made by Shepherdstown resident Mary C. Bell in memory of her late wife, Sandra Jenkins.

"Sandra was a great believer in 'the spark' — that magical moment when a young person discovers a nugget of knowledge that excites and engages her or him," said Mary, pictured here with Monica Lingenfelter, executive vice president of the Shepherd University Foundation. "She firmly believed in the Seeding Your Future Initiative as a place where sparks can fly!"

The Seeding Your Future Initiative (SYFI) was founded in 2015 by associate professor of physics Sytil Murphy and former assistant professor of chemistry Jordan Mader, colleagues in Shepherd University's Institute of Environmental and Physical Sciences. The program encourages middle school-aged girls, grades 5-8, to pursue careers in science, technology, engineering, art, and mathematics (STEAM). In early 2020, an article about SYFI in Shepherd University's alumni magazine noted the program was on hiatus following an unsuccessful bid to secure additional funding. It was this feature that motivated Mary to make her gift as a tribute to Sandra, who had long believed that STEAM fields would benefit from more women and vice versa.



REMEMBERING DR. SCOTT BEARD

In late March 2021, the Shepherd community was shocked and saddened to learn of the sudden and unexpected passing of Dr. Scott Beard, provost and vice president for academic affairs. A graduate of the Peabody Institute at Johns Hopkins University, Dr. Beard was also a full professor in Shepherd University's School of Music. In addition to his undergraduate degree, he held a Master of Music and Doctor of Musical Arts, both from the University of Maryland, College Park.

Dr. Beard's responsibilities at Shepherd included the oversight of all graduate programs and institutional and programmatic accreditation, as well as cyclical program reviews, development of new degree program proposals, and campus representation for academic affairs. Major accomplishments during his tenure included the successful implementation of Shepherd's first doctoral program, the doctor of nursing practice, and Shepherd's first certificate program at the graduate level in Appalachian studies. Recognized for his outstanding teaching abilities, Dr. Beard was named West Virginia Music Teacher of the Year in 2006 and was runner-up for West Virginia Professor of the Year in 2009.

Administrator, teacher, concert pianist, and friend, Dr. Beard's passing has left a heartbreaking void at Shepherd and within the greater community. LEGACY GIFT PROVIDES SUPPORT TO PREVIOUSLY ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

In 2020, a legacy gift made through the Shepherd University Foundation from the Carrol E. Kline and Mary Ellen Kline Trust helped support a named scholarship previously endowed by the couple during their lifetimes. The Carrol and Mary Ellen Wareham Kline Scholarship is a general academic award designated for residents of Berkeley, Jefferson, and Morgan counties in West Virginia.

Hailing from Hagerstown, Maryland, Carrol Kline '50 and Mary Ellen Wareham Kline '51 graduated from Shepherd College and went on to enjoy fulfilling careers in education with Washington County Public Schools in Maryland. Prior to his teaching career, Carrol was a pilot with the Army Air Corps and a World War II veteran. He also wrote poetry and published a book of poems reflecting on his time in the service and other observations throughout his life. Carrol passed away in 2015 at the age of 90, and Mary Ellen — known to friends and family as Tudy — followed in 2020.

"My aunt and uncle shared positive feelings about Shepherd because it directed their life's work," said Linda Golden, the Klines' niece and trustee. "They believed everyone should have access to a college education and that is why they chose to make this gift."
