FRATERNITY & SORORITY LIFE: GPA'S

Every FSL organization had an above average cumulative and semester for the Fall 2021 semester. While the overall average cumulative GPA for Shepherd students is 3.12 for females and 2.95 for males, the students who are members of a FSL organization averaged a GPA of 3.29 for females and 3.13 for males.

FRATERNITY & SORORITY LIFE: COMMUNITY SERVICE

In the Fall 2021 semester, Fraternity and Sorority Life groups raised over \$5,000 to support charities including the Eastern Panhandle Empowerment Center, Shepherd Last Dollar Fund, March of Dimes, St. Jude Children's Hospital, the Fisher House Foundation, and more. Additionally, the FSL community also devoted 688 hours of their time to community service from September through December.

FRATERNITY & SORORITY LIFE: CONSENT WEEK

Fraternity and Sorority Life and Student Affairs partnered with the Stubblefield Institute's *ListenLearnEngage* Initiative to host Consent Week from February 7-11. Activities were focused on the theme "Leading with Integrity" and centered on healthy relationships, communication skills, and understanding power dynamics. Student leaders and staff worked together to provide peer education on the meaning and importance of consent through themed events, a group poster competition, two social media challenges, and a training with guest speaker, author, and CEO of A Call to Men, Tony Porter on February 9.

STUDENT ACTIVITIES: LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

Student Activities and Leadership partnered with the Stubblefield Insititute's *ListenLearnEngage* Initiative, and TRiO support services to host a virtual **Student Leadership Conference** on Saturday, February 5. There will be two additional breakout sessions by outstanding guest

presenters. The Student Leadership Conference featured Dr. Allison Jackson, TED talk speaker & expert on overcoming adversity and building resilience with as session titled, *Re-envisioning Leadership for a Better World*.






