NICHOLAS LEFTWICH, state drug court coordinator for the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia, will discuss "Treatment Courts and Probation," a lecture which is free and open to the public. Leftwich will delve into the nuances of how treatment courts in West Virginia operate as well as how probation officers work in the field.

Leftwich oversees programmatic and fiscal stewardship of all treatment courts in West Virginia. The state has four treatment courts—Adult Drug Court, Juvenile Drug Court, Family Treatment Courts, and Veterans Treatment Court. Leftwich works with all probation officers in the state to provide any and all technical assistance and serves as a resource to the field officers.
