RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

Shepherd University believes living on-campus is a crucial piece of a student's educational experience. Thus, all Shepherd students are required to live on-campus while enrolled. The requirement continues unless and until the student applies for and is granted a residency requirement exception.

Those considering living off-campus must (1) meet qualifying exception criteria and (2) complete the **Off-Campus Request form** on the Good Living Portal. **We urge you NOT to sign a lease or other commitments until you have been notified of off-campus approval** or you will have two financially binding obligations.
