Students will also work on academic preparation and skill-building through a **1-credit First-Year Experience (FYEX) course**.

Students registered full-time in the fall (12 credits or more) will incur no additional charges for this course. This FYEX course will begin during the L.E.A.D.S. program and extend into the first half of the fall semester.*
