DUAL ENROLLMENT INFORMATION
Students attending a high school in Berkeley County may be enrolled in both high school and college at the same time, while receiving college and high school credit simultaneously. College credits will count toward a degree at Shepherd or may transfer to other U.S. colleges and universities. Students enjoy a discounted rate of \$84 per credit.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Meet with high school counselor to determine eligibility and whether courses count as required or elective.
- Completed online application.
- Approval or recommendation from high school counselor or principal.
- Overall GPA of 3.0 or higher.

MAIN CAMPUS CREDIT OPTIONS

- **80+ classes available on main campus**

- **Student chooses from Shepherd's class schedule**
(various days and times, online/hybrid/in-person)

- **Students may take 11 credits per semester (3 courses).** More with written request approval





DUAL CREDIT REQUIREMENTS

- **For students to receive the full year of high school “dual credit” for graduation, they must take two approved courses in a subject area.**
 - ▶ *Example: **ENGL 101** in Fall + **ENGL 102** in Spring = one high school graduation English credit*

REQUIREMENTS

- **Junior/Senior standing (dual credit)**
- **3.00 cumulative GPA**
- **Approval of parent/legal guardian**
- **Approval of high school counselor**
- **SAT/ACT/Accuplacer scores if enrolling in ENGL 101, CIS 104, ECON 205, ENGR 101, MATH 105 or higher**



REQUIREMENTS

- **Official SAT/ACT/Accuplacer scores must be on file with Shepherd before a student can be registered for ENGL 101, MATH 105 or higher, CIS 104, ENGR 101, or ECON 205**
- **If using an AP score as a pre-requisite, Shepherd must also receive the official test results before a student can be registered.**



REQUIREMENTS

- **When scheduling your ACT or SAT, be sure to list Shepherd University**
 - ▷ **ACT code: 4532**
 - ▷ **SAT code: 5615**

- **You can list up to 4 schools/organizations for FREE – including Promise Scholarship (ACT code: 4539, SAT code: 3456)**



REQUIREMENTS

- **The Accuplacer is placement exam a student can take at Shepherd to qualify for certain courses (ENGL 101/MATH 105/ECON 205/CIS 104)**
- **Virtual testing available.**
- **To schedule an Accuplacer, visit www.shepherd.edu/accuplacer**

Student Type Descriptions

First Time in College - Current seniors in high school or students who have graduated and have not enrolled in a college or university after graduating.

Transfer - Those who have attended college after graduating high school.

Readmit - Former Shepherd students who have taken time off from their studies or are returning to Shepherd for another degree.

Transfer/Readmit - Former Shepherd students who attended a different college after leaving Shepherd.

High School Dual Enrollment - Current high school juniors and seniors who wish to take courses at Shepherd while still enrolled in high school.

Special Non-Degree - Students who wish to take fewer than seven (7) credits to transfer to another school or for personal enrichment.

- **Applications submitted to Shepherd by May 1 will be considered for priority scheduling.**
- **Registration in mid-May. We will need a high school transcript and test scores (for ENGL 101/ENGR 101/CIS 104/ECON 205/MATH 105 or higher) to complete the registration process.**
- **Orientation will be held in August**
