You will be enrolled in high school and college at the same time.

You can get a head start earning college credit while completing important high school credits towards graduation.





Why Participate?

Great opportunity to prepare for college

Enjoy a discounted rate of \$84 per credit

- > 3 credit class = \$252
- Plus cost of books, course fees, etc.
- State funded RAM READY pathways available



Classes transfer to most US colleges nationwide

(Some ivy league and military institutions have specific policies regarding dual enrollment credits)

MAIN CAMPUS CREDIT OPTIONS

80+ classes available on main campus



- Student chooses from Shepherd's class schedule (various days and times, online/hybrid/in-person)
- Students may take 11 credits per semester (3 courses). More with written request approval



DUAL CREDIT REQUIREMENTS

For students to receive the full year of high school "dual credit" for graduation, they must take two approved courses in a subject area.

Example: ENGL 101 in Fall + ENGL 102 in Spring = one high school graduation English credit

- Junior/Senior standing (dual credit)
- 3.00 cumulative GPA
- Approval of parent/legal guardian
- Approval of high school counselor
- SAT/ACT/Accuplacer scores if enrolling in ENGL 101, CIS 104, ECON 205, ENGR 101, MATH 105 or higher



 Official SAT/ACT/Accuplacer scores must be on file with Shepherd before a student can be registered for ENGL 101, MATH 105 or higher, CIS 104, ENGR 101, or ECON 205

If using an AP score as a pre-requisite, Shepherd must also receive the official test results before a student can be registered.

You can list up to 4 schools/organizations for FREE — including Promise Scholarship (ACT code: 4539, SAT code: 3456)




- The Accuplacer is placement exam a student can take at Shepherd to qualify for certain courses (ENGL 101/MATH 105/ECON 205/CIS 104)







HOW TO CHOOSE YOUR COURSES

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applications submitted to Shepherd by May 1 will be considered for priority scheduling.
- Registration in mid-May. We will need a high school transcript and test scores (for ENGL 101/ENGR 101/CIS 104/ECON 205/MATH 105 or higher) to complete the registration process.
- Orientation will be held in August
