Individuals who complete an Educator Preparation Program approved by the West Virginia Board of Education and leading to West Virginia licensure <u>must meet</u> all testing requirements of that program unless exempted by current Board policy.

Candidates may take the "Core Academic Skills for Educators (CASE)" assessments in Reading, Writing, and/or Mathematics OR provide proof of exemption (see the most current WVDE Licensure Testing Directory).

Shepherd University has adopted the WVDE's Policy 5202 as follows:

Candidate "has attained a 'B' or better in any of three courses addressing the basic skills of Reading (ENGL 102), Writing (ENGL 101/101S), and Mathematics (as indicated by college and career ready standards) at an accredited institution of Higher Education providing that each course is a minimum of 3 semester credit hours (or equivalent)." If you need to take the Praxis CORE/CASE test(s), go to http://www.ets.org and choose PRAXIS and CHOOSE WV. You must include BOTH Shepherd University (5615) and the West Virginia Department of Education (8480) as score recipients.

If you wish to take all three computer-delivered CORE/CASE exams (5713, 5723, 5733) at the same time, select Core Academic Skills for Educators: Combined Test (5752) when registering. Scores will be reported by individual test (5713, 5723, 5733).
