We understand that a complete withdrawal from a semester is sometimes unavoidable. However, we want you to be aware that a complete withdrawal can also carry some potentially serious consequences, including but not limited to the following:

### **Students currently on Academic Probation**

A complete withdrawal after the 5<sup>th</sup> week of a semester results in an immediate suspension for the next semester.

### **Athletes**

A complete withdrawal from a semester will seriously affect your ability to remain eligible to participate in varsity athletics.

### **Dependent Students**

A complete withdrawal from a semester may mean that you are no longer eligible to be carried on a parent/guardian insurance policy.

### Students receiving Financial Aid

- A complete withdrawal from a semester can end loan deferments.
- A complete withdrawal from a semester can make you ineligible for grants and scholarships that require a minimum number of earned hours for renewal.
- A complete withdrawal from a semester can affect your Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) for financial aid.

### **Graduate Students**

If you were admitted on Provisional Status, a complete withdrawal will affect your ability to move to normal status at the end of the probationary period, and may result in academic dismissal.

#### International Students

- A complete withdrawal from a semester can affect your eligibility to remain in the U.S.
- Your SEVIS record must be updated immediately, alerting the Department of Homeland Security.

### **Residence Hall Students**

- A complete withdrawal from a semester usually means that, except for a <u>documented</u> medical emergency, you will receive no refund for housing.
- Meals are prorated from the date that you officially check out of the residence hall.

#### **Veterans using Veterans Administration State or Federal Benefits**

- A complete withdrawal from a semester can prompt the VA to bill you for the funds it disbursed on your behalf.
- A complete withdrawal from a semester can cause problems with Tuition Assistance contracts.
