- II. **Reports**
  - A. C&I (Craig Cline: nothing to report)
  - B. Assessment (Ann Wendle): *Note: Ann is unable to attend because of the meeting schedule.*
  - C. Course Substitution Subcommittee (Kathy Reid, Brian Santana, and Jacqui Cole)
    - a. Kathy states that the subcommittee was requested to review two course substitutions; unanimous votes on 1 course; other course has outstanding votes
    - b. Chair is still needed for the subcommittee
    - c. A new folder on the TEAMS site for the subcommittee is accessible for members
- III. **New Business**
  - A. Assessment

- a. For accreditation, a stronger plan is needed for the competencies and the initiatives are being evaluated, and when and how they are being evaluated
- b. Developing a cycle for each competency discussed
- c. Documented approach may be a better idea
- d. Multiple competencies may be evaluated, but with only one measure
  - i. At least one assessment of everything each cycle
  - ii. 2 measures that address a competency in a class
  - iii. Importance of documentation discussed
- e. Chris has some archives that include examples; these will be put on the TEAMS page
- f. Monica will work with getting recording of meeting and minutes to Ann Wendle
- g. Proposal from Kathy that the assessment subcommittee work with Ann Wendle to develop an assessment rotation for Core classes was discussed

  - a. Full roster
  - b. 2 new student representatives elected by SGA
    - i. Logan Morgan introduced
- B. Core Codes update
  - a. questions by Dr. Best on why we use just the current worksheet, clarification posted to website. Students are to use current worksheet regardless of the student's catalog year
  - b. Repositories – Monica has been looking at items on the website to ensure they are up to date; there are a lot of outdated sources of information
  - c. core curriculum Framework revised in 2023.
    - i. Writing in the Major did not have written communication; this has been added in the draft
  - d. Initial framework and course mapping could be eliminated and refer readers to current worksheet; Needs proofread and edited
  - e. DRAFT Framework REVISED Fall 2024 – Chris Lovelace started this previously and will work with Sam Green who is taking over the position in the committee
  - f. Forms and Instructions – competency mapping diagram has not been updated with written communication from Writing in the Major;
  - g. Question raised; if changes are made to the document, will this need to be approved by Faculty Senate?
    - i. Monica will find out for committee
  - h. Sakai is archived on a folder in the TEAMS>General>Archive from Sakai
- C. Investigation into the Core Curriculum and Degree Offerings
  - a. Timeline discussed
    - i. Steps that were determined were not clear
  - b. Reviewing AACU's LEAP goals
    - i. Rubrics written in 2011 (Cole) – may not be effective now with changes since 2011
    - ii. More standardized assessments
    - iii. Possible answer; let this mellow online and everyone can make suggested edits and review at next meeting
  - c. Tracy asked if updates are being done by AACU;

- i. Chris states it's still on the AACU website; essential learning outcomes are listed; value assessment guidelines are still being used and being used in tandem with Leap goals;
    - ii. VALUE assessment initiative discussed
      - 1. appears to be more of a rebranding.
      - 2. Integrative and Applied learning was only change noted
  - d. Referring to Leap goals is still useful, but alternatives need to be considered
  - e. Needing someone to look at web content
  - f. Motion made by Sara Reynolds to approve the statement as it
    - i. Yea = 14
    - ii. Nay = 1
    - iii. Motion passed
  - g. Definition of degrees
    - i. Registrar has clear layout of a tactical standpoint
    - ii. 'Philosophical' definition of degrees is needed
  - h. US Higher Education: A brief guide explains what degrees mean in the US system
  - i. In the strategic plan, this is probably what is being looked for
    - i. Volunteers for basic work on this and present to the committee
    - ii. Would be a working group
      - 1. John and Sara, Keith agree to work on this
